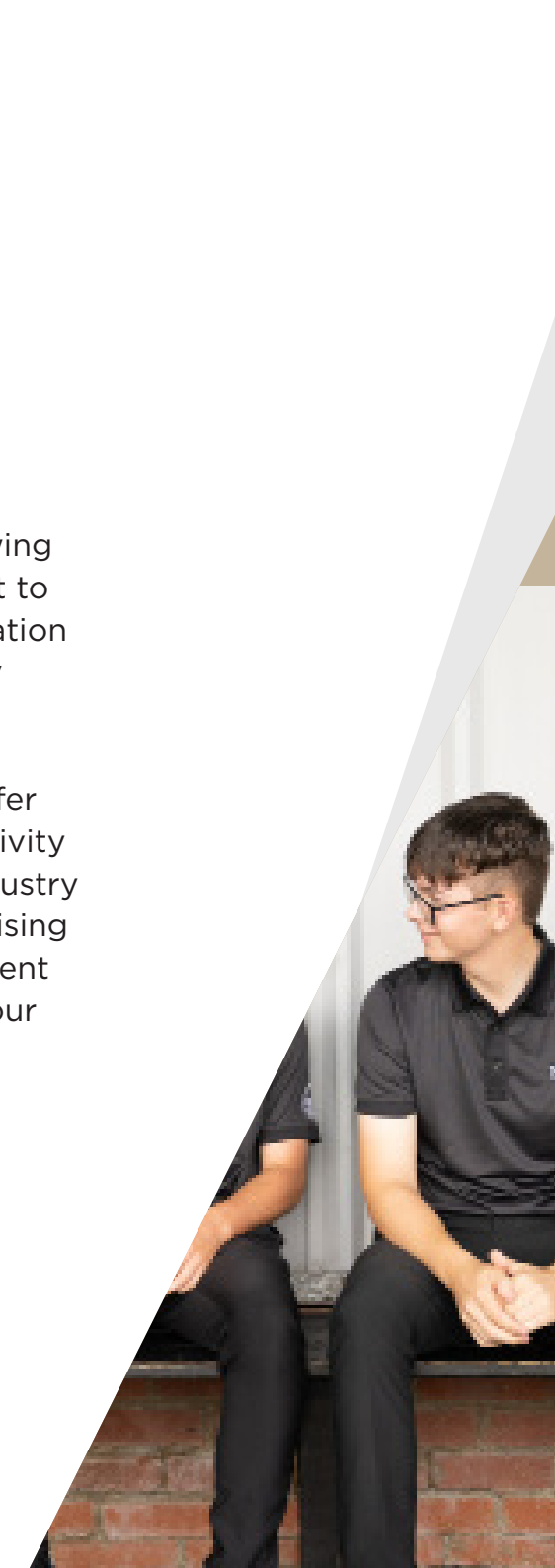

KGC is the first and only golf specific college in Kent and affords schools leavers the opportunity to dedicate themselves to improving their golf games during their last two years of compulsory education.



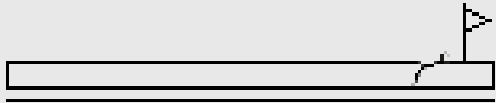
KENT GOLF COLLEGE HAS THREE MAIN OBJECTIVES:

The academic programme is equivalent to 3 A-levels and carries UCAS points so all exit routes following graduation from LGC are open, whether this be a US Scholarships, UK University degrees, PGA Professional or any other employment.
2. **TO COACH** you to give you the opportunity to become the best golfer you can be. KGC students have 9+ hours per week of golf related activity under the guidance of PGA qualified coaches', all using the latest industry leading technologies. Students work on all aspects of their game utilising the excellent facilities at Pedham Place Golf Centert. Students represent KGC in regional and national competitions as well as competing for our own Order of Merit title, Matchplay and Championship titles.
3. **TO DEVELOP** you to enhance the skills needed for a successful and happy future. Students at KGC will graduate having significantly reduced their handicap and will have achieved a level 3 qualification, however just as importantly the students will have developed their 'soft skills', crucial for future employment.

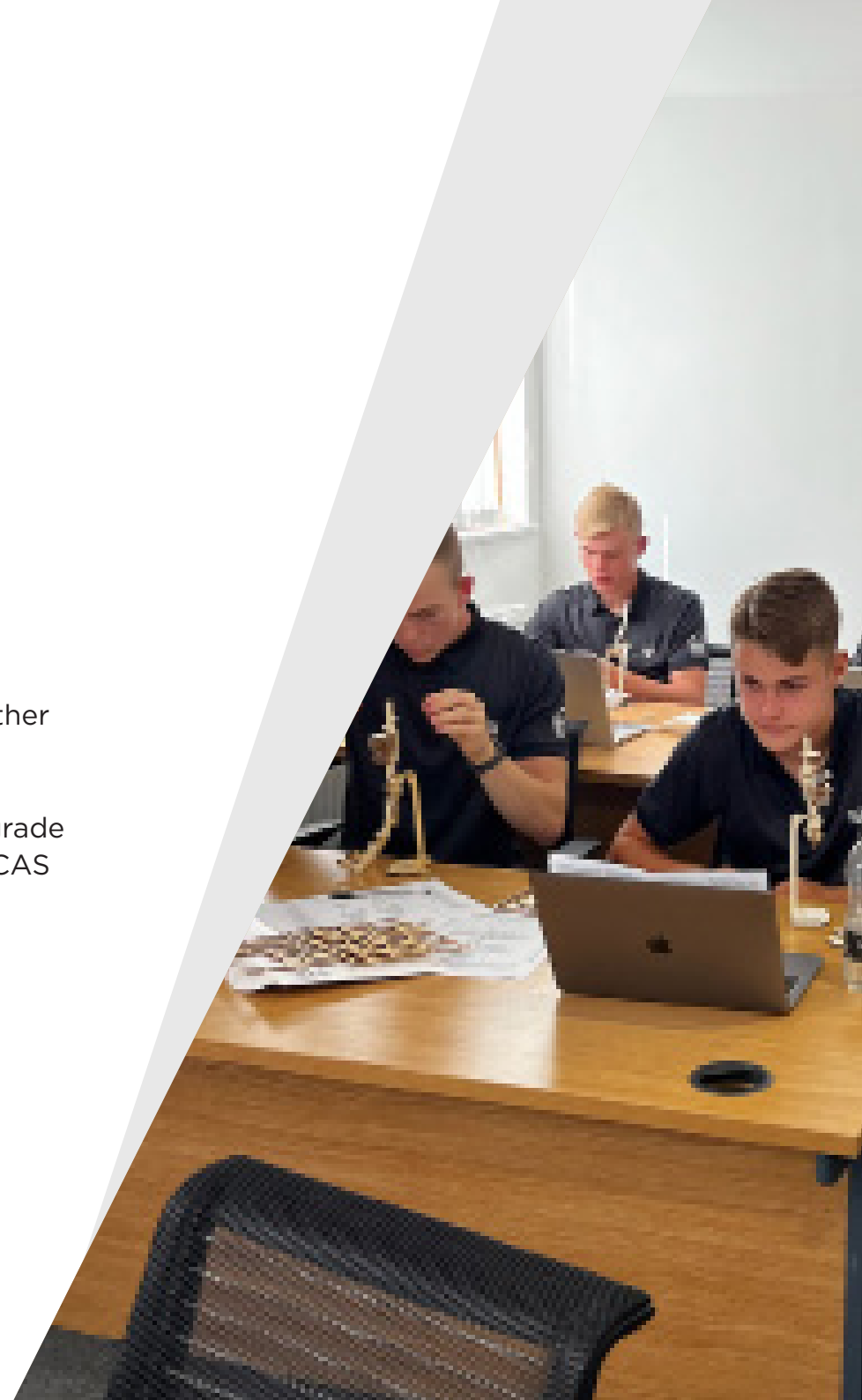

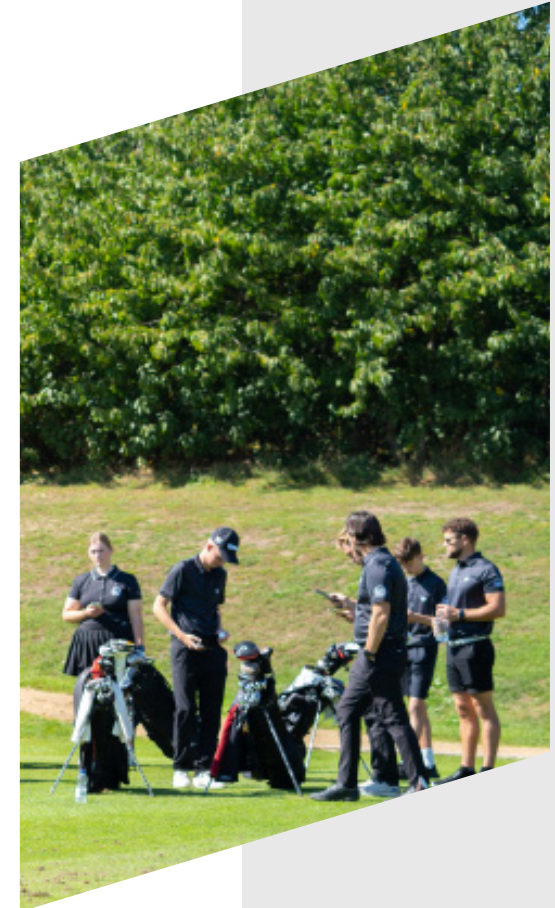

During the swing, the average male recruits about 30 pounds of muscle and uses nearly everyd-oin in the body to produce 2,000 goun s of force in less than 0.2 seconds.

Research has found a relationship between:

- Strength and driving distance and accuracy
- Lower body power and total driving stats
- Core stability and injury prevention
- Aerobic capacity and chip shot efficacy and putting average

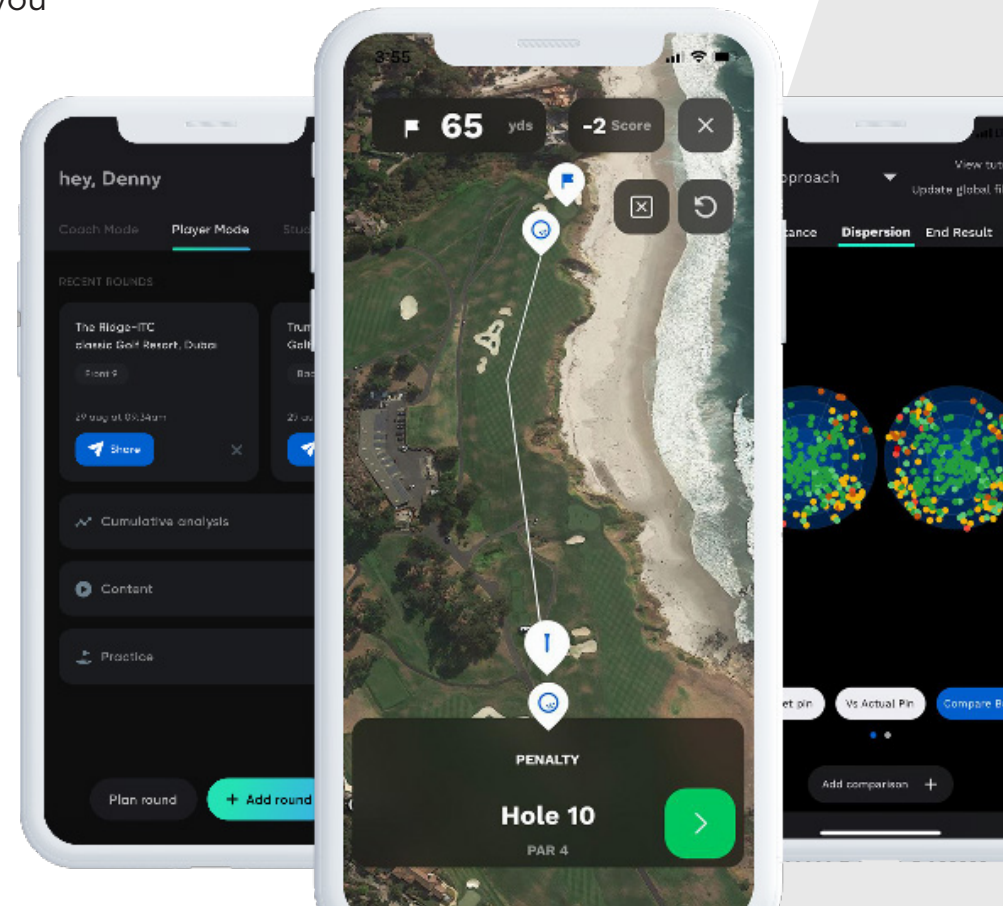

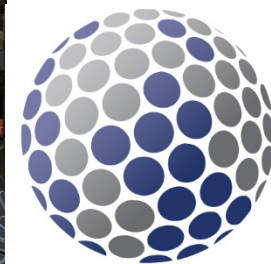

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1

Academically, students need to have passed English and maths at level-4 or above to enroll on the 2-year Extended Diploma

If this is not achieved students will be enrolled on the 2-year Diploma, with an optional 3rd year online top-up to achieve the Extended Diploma.

Students need to demonstrate the required level of golf ability by achieving a WHS Index of 18 or less.

Places are secured following the receipt of an application form, proof of WHS Index and deposit payment.
